Activity Overview

The Aesthetic Injectables program prepares licensed medical professionals to safely and effectively administer aesthetic injectables, including botulinum toxin and dermal fillers. With emphasis on both theoretical knowledge and clinical practice, this program bridges the gap between traditional education and the advanced skills required in the growing field of aesthetic medicine. Students will gain an in-depth understanding of facial anatomy, pharmacology, injection techniques, consultation skills, complication management, and medical ethics. The program is delivered in a hybrid format, combining online coursework with supervised, in-person clinical experience.

Target Audience
